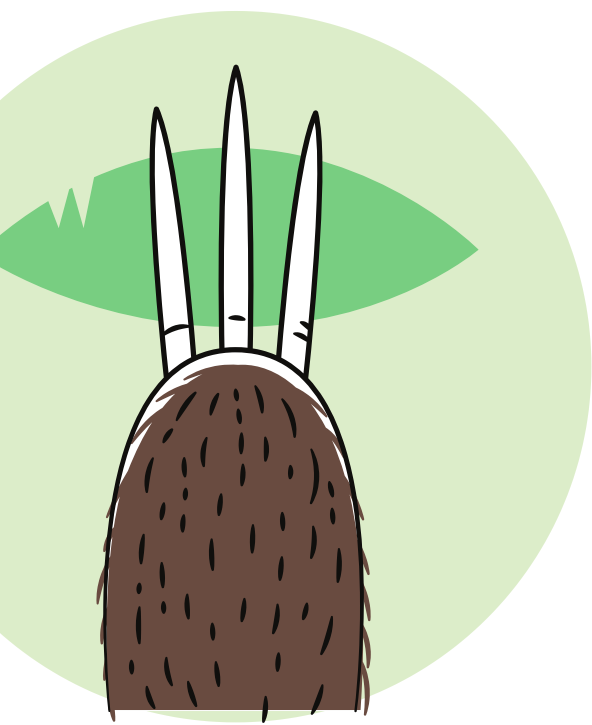




FOUR SLOTH FACTS TO KNOW



WHAT DO SLOTHS EAT?

Sloths are mostly herbivores and are known to eat leaves as well as buds and twigs. They are very slow to digest their food...as you'd expect from a sloth!

HOW MANY TYPES OF SLOTHS ARE THERE?

There are two types of sloth: two-toed and three-toed sloths, but between those two types, six known species of sloth exist.



WHERE DO SLOTHS LIVE?

No, they don't live on the sofa! Sloths live in tropical forests in Central and South America. They depend on the health of these tropical forests for their survival. Some species are threatened by habitat loss.

ARE SLOTHS REALLY SLOW?

Yes, sloths are slow. They have a slow metabolic rate, sleep anywhere from 15-20 hours/day depending on the species, and, according to the World Wildlife Fund, only move about 41 yards per day.
